

## JANUARY 1, 2023 ~ OCTAVE OF THE NATIVITY OF THE LORD

**I**NTRIT: A Child is born to us, a Son is given to us; upon His shoulder dominion rests; and His name shall be called the Angel of great counsel. Sing to the Lord a new song, for He has done wondrous deeds.

**C**OLLECT: O God, You Who by the fruitful virginity of blessed Mary, have bestowed upon mankind the rewards of eternal salvation, grant, we beseech You, that we may enjoy the intercession of her through whom we have been found worthy to receive among us the author of life, our Lord Jesus Christ Your Son.

**E**PISTLE: (1 Titus 2:11-15) Beloved: The grace of God our Saviour has appeared to all men, instructing us, in order that, rejecting ungodliness and worldly lusts, we may live temperately and justly and piously in this world; looking for the blessed hope and glorious coming of our great God and Saviour, Jesus Christ, Who gave Himself for us that He might redeem us from all iniquity and cleanse for Himself an acceptable people, pursuing good works. Thus speak, and exhort, in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**G**RADUAL: All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation by our God. Sing joyfully to God, all you lands. 
## LEGION OF MARY
